Report from the 2009 Annual General Meeting and Awards Banquet

Friday October 23rd, 2009 at Peterborough, Ontario

Meeting Minutes:

Lynne Milford opened the meeting and introduced the Board of Directors to the membership. She indicated that Susan Lavery, Nicole Donaldson-Ahern and Marion Castleton would be stepping down for 2010, and that there would be 3 new places on the Board of Directors to fill.

Brenda Koenig gave a brief membership report. The KLDA has approximately 70 members at this time.

Lisa Hossack-Scott reported that by the end of the year, the association should show a profit of approximately \$800 for 2009.

Just a Reminder...

All persons wishing to compete at the Bronze level of competition in 2010, must purchase a Sport License from EC. A Sport License at the Bronze level costs \$20.00 per year. The Sport License is to be purchased through EC.

In addition to the Sport License fee, there are 2 additional fees that apply to the Bronze level of competition – an EC drug testing fee and a Dressage Canada (DC) Levy. The EC drug testing fee is \$3.50 per entry per show. The DC levy is \$7.00 per entry per show. These fees are due with the entry forms submitted at each horse show you enter in 2010. We recommend that you visit both the Equine Canada website at www.equinecanada.ca and Dressage Canada website www.dressagecanada.org for further information and details.


