EC Statement of Principles

Equestrian Canada (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to the humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedures.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.

- Requiring owner, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
 - Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.
- The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition practices, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES – Entries close August 21, 2017 and will not be accepted unless accompanied by:

1. Photocopies of 2017 EC and DC membership cards for Rider & Owner (Gold-both/Silver-both/Bronze-EC)
2. Your signed waiver
3. Your accurate and complete entry form
4. Your current dated cheque, made payable to **H2S Management Inc.** Alternative to a cheque an email money transfer to the show secretary is accepted.

Faxed or Emailed entries are subject to a \$25.00 service charge and must be paid by closing date to not incur a Late Fee. Fax is NOT available after Aug 31.	Any cheques returned by the bank for any reason, are subject to a \$60.00 fee.
Late entries are those received or not fully paid for AFTER midnight on August 15 and are subject to a late fee and will only be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee. 5 days late = \$25 late fee. 6+ days late = \$50 late fee.	
The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse entries for any reason.	

CLOSING DATE	The closing date for entries is August 21, 2017 . If you courier and request a signature, entry will be delayed by no less than 1 day so this is not a recommended method.
CATEGORIES	Those wishing to compete in two categories (i.e. AA and Open) will pay two entry fees, but will ride one test; the score will count for both categories at a discount of \$50 per division or \$25 per class. If there are fewer than six (6) entries per category at any level the organizing committee has the option of holding only the open category or combining any two (2) categories together.
Combining Championships	Please refer to the chart before the class list to see how championships can be combined. The Canadian National, Eastern Region can be added to the Ontario Championships. The Canadian National Youth can be added to the Canadian Championships. The Kawartha Fall Classic Champions can be added to any other Provincial or National Championship. The additional cost to combine when classes are not ridden is primarily to cover the cost of awards, just in case you were wondering. Please contact the secretary if you are unsure of how to add championships.
Presentations	Will be mounted for the Canadian and Provincial Championships. The schedule will be posted during the competition.
Kawartha Fall Classic Championships	Kawartha Fall Classic Championships will be per the chart detailed previously. If competitors wish to use their Ontario or Canadian Championship scores toward these championships they pay \$25 per test for this purpose. These Championships will be determined on Sunday. Where there is only one competitor at the level a Championship will not be declared.
CANCELLATIONS	Cancellations will only be accepted with a Veterinarian/Physician Certificate stating that the horse/rider is unable to compete. Refunds of 100% of class entry and stabling fees (no admin fee refund), will be allowed up until the closing date (Aug 21, 2017). Refunds of 50% of class entry fees, less administration fee, will be made after the closing date and before the start of the show. There will be no refunds on stabling fees after the closing date. Scratches after 12 noon on Aug 31 will lose the total entry and stabling fee.

HORS CONCOURS	Hors Concours entries will not be accepted.
EC Horse Recording	All Silver and Gold: ALL Canadian entries are required to provide proof of a current year activated EC Horse Recording to compete, or if owned by a temporary sport license holder, a Temporary Horse Registration form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit. (A602.4) Any ponies requiring measurement will be measured on Thursday at 6pm, location tba
NUMBERS	All competition and non-showing horses must wear a number at all times in the schooling and exercise areas and in the competition rings. Passports will be returned upon return of number.
NON-SHOWING HORSES	There is a \$50.00 charge per show day for non-showing horses. Non-showing horses are subject to all the rules pertaining to competing horses. Non-showing horse entries may be declined if stabling space is not available.
RIDING TIMES	Riding times will be available at www.foxvillage.com no later than August 29th, 2017. The times will change frequently after initial posting due to entry changes. It is the riders responsibility to check for current times every competition day.
QUERIES	Questions concerning rules, scoring or entries may be made to the Steward for discussion with the Organizing Committee. Protests must be made in writing within 48 hours of the completion of the class and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00, cash or certified cheque. See EC Rules
STABLING	The cost per stall is \$195.00 for the weekend (Thurs-Sun). While we try to accommodate all requests and work primarily on a first come basis, stabling assignment is at the discretion of the organizer. Stalls will not be bedded, please bring your own shavings or shavings will be available at \$9.00 per bag. Please bring your own hay, feed and buckets. Wednesday night or earlier arrival by special request, \$50.00 extra per day or part thereof. Stabling opens at 12 noon on Thursday and horses must leave by 8pm on Sunday. Day stabling may be available if space permits. The cost is \$100 per day and is only for the period of 7 am to 6 pm for that one day. If day stabling is booked with the entry and not available that fee will be fully refunded
HELMETS	EC Rules, Section E, Dressage ARTICLE E 4.0 SAFETY HEADGEAR: All riders, regardless of age or level or competition, must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location. Note: At the tack check which follows the test, the steward may ask the rider to dismount so that the helmet may be inspected for the ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN label.
DRUG TESTING	EC/FEI Drug and Medications rules apply at these shows. Any horse entered in any class at any competition may, while on the competition grounds, may be selected for equine medication control testing.
INSURANCE	All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events is necessary.
RIBBONS	Ribbons will be presented to 6 th place as well as division champion and reserve champion as noted.
CLASSES	The organizing committee reserves the right to combine or split classes at its discretion.
FREESTYLE MUSIC	Must be submitted when competitor package is picked up and on CD.
PARKING	Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only. There will be no parking on the roads and the barn areas at any time. After unloading, do not park in the stable area. The gates to the stable area will remain closed to vehicles during the hours of the competition.
SECURITY	Security will not be provided. The show organizers and the facility accept no responsibility for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave items unattended.
DOGS	If you must bring your furry friend, please make sure 1. you stoop & scoop, 2. do not allow your friend to run loose, 3. you use a leash that can extend no longer than 2 metres. Penalties will be levied for any offenders.
Warm up	Warm up will be available as posted. Competition rings will be open to riders on Thursday until 6 pm. After that time, competition rings may be available daily after the last horse of the day. Times will be posted. Please ensure that you wear your competition number at all times.

All scores should be a minimum of 53% for the Ontario Championship and 60% for the Canadian Championship. FEI Level: Two scores (minimum 53% for the Ontario Championship and 60% for the Canadian Championship) at the relevant level must be submitted.
